1 A BILL supplementing, amending, and increasing existing items of appropriation from the State  
2 Road Fund to the Department of Transportation, Division of Highways, fund 9017, fiscal  
3 year 2023, organization 0803, for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2023.

1 Whereas, The Governor submitted to the Legislature the Executive Budget Document,  
2 dated January 11, 2023, which included a statement of the State Road Fund setting forth therein  
3 the cash balances and investments as of July 1, 2022, and further included the revised estimate of  
4 revenues for the fiscal year 2023, less regular appropriations for the fiscal year 2023; and

5 Whereas, It appears from the Statement of the State Road Fund there now remains an  
6 unappropriated balance in the State Treasury which is available for appropriation during the fiscal  
7 year ending June 30, 2023; therefore

*Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:*

1 That the total appropriation for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2023, to fund 9017, fiscal  
2 year 2023, organization 0803, be supplemented and amended by increasing existing items of  
3 appropriation as follows:
