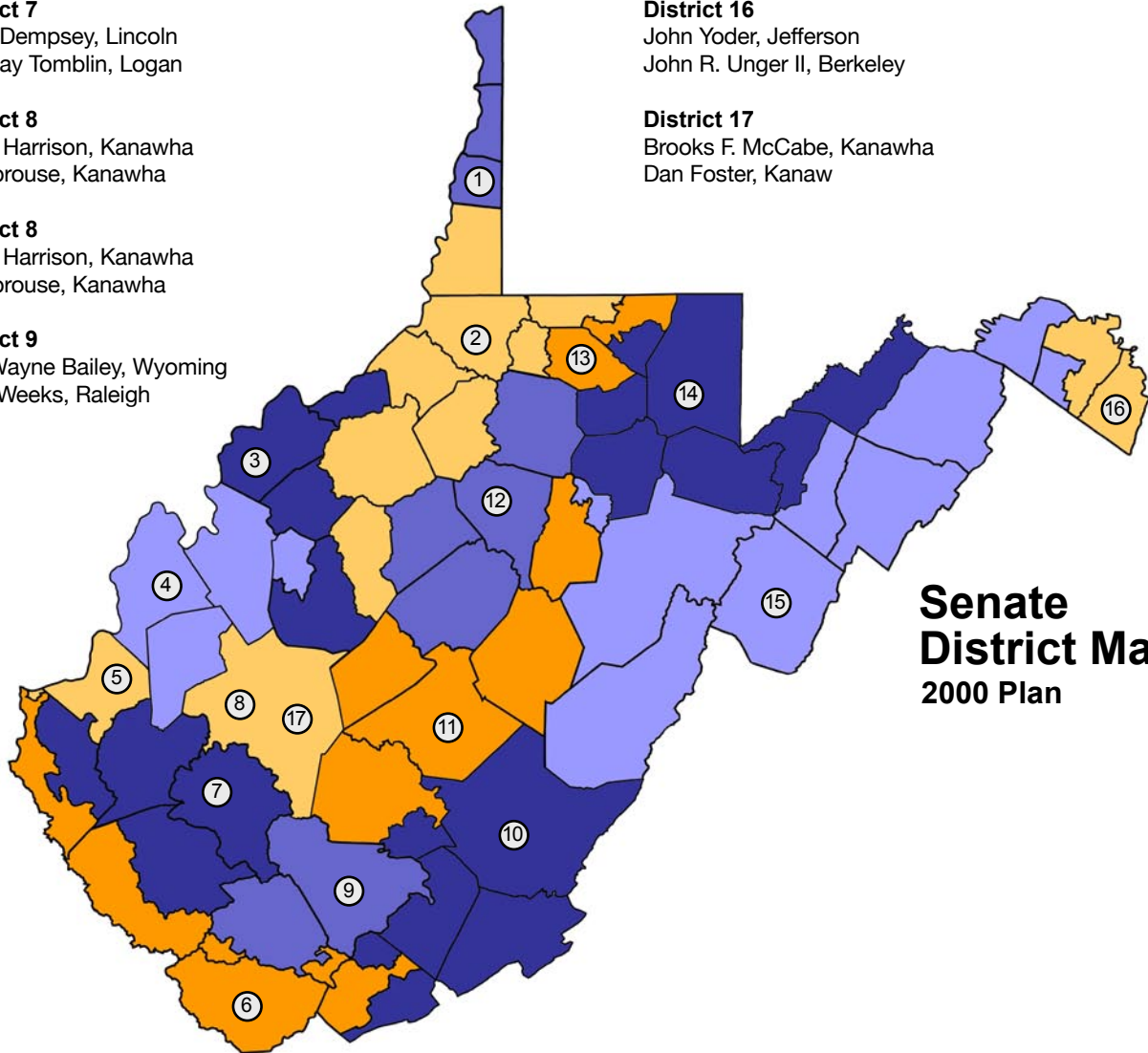

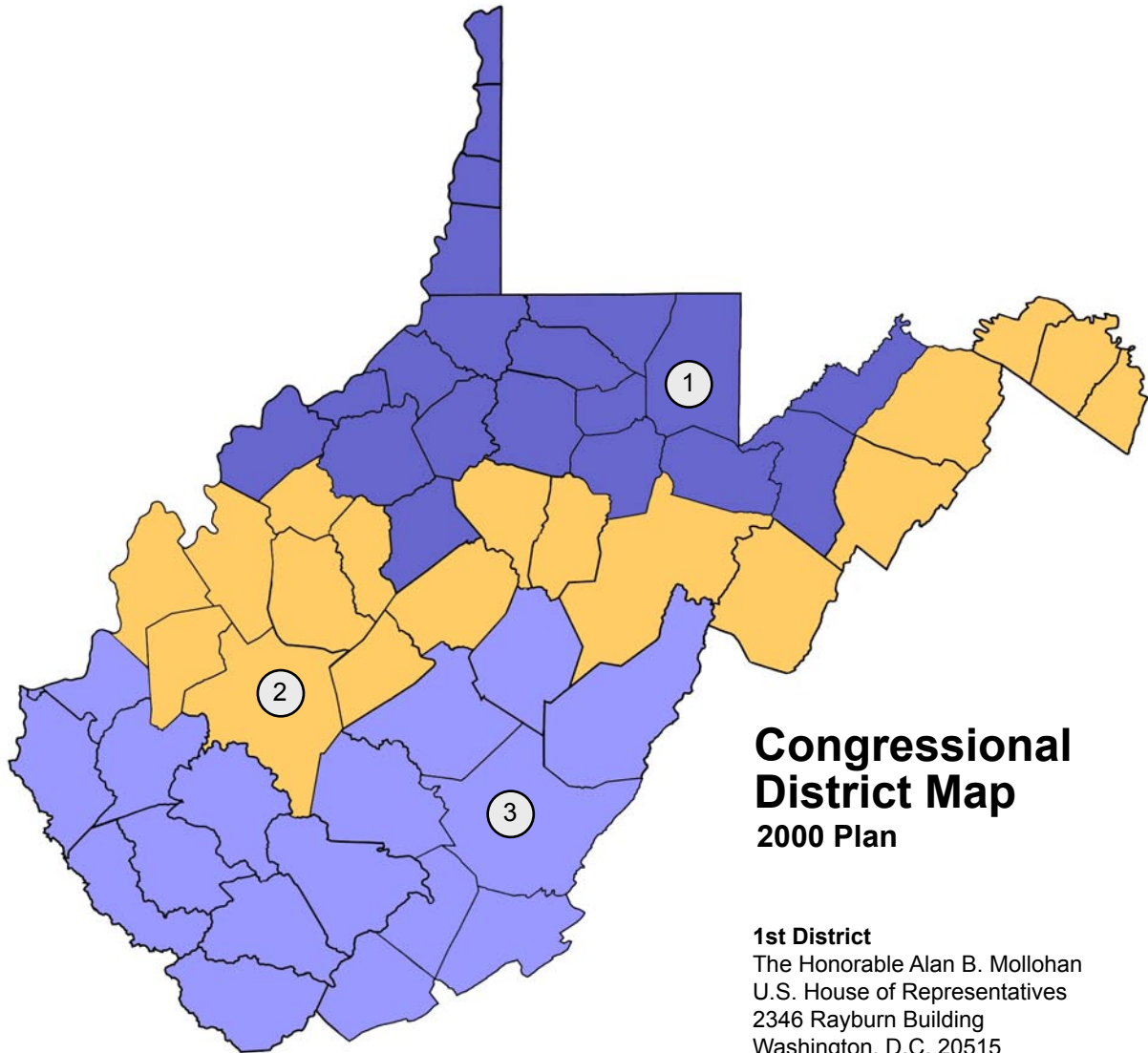

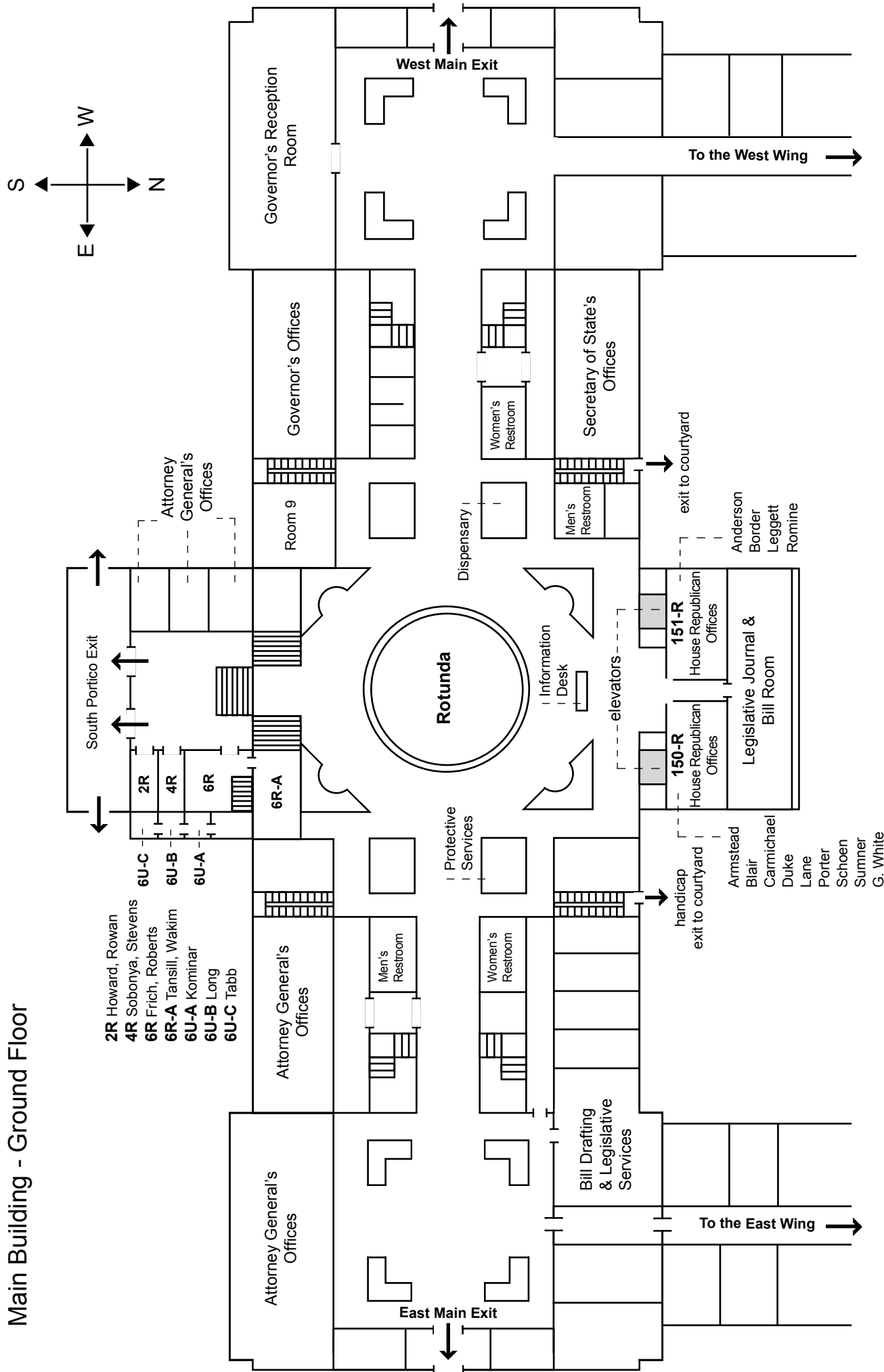

Main Building - Basement



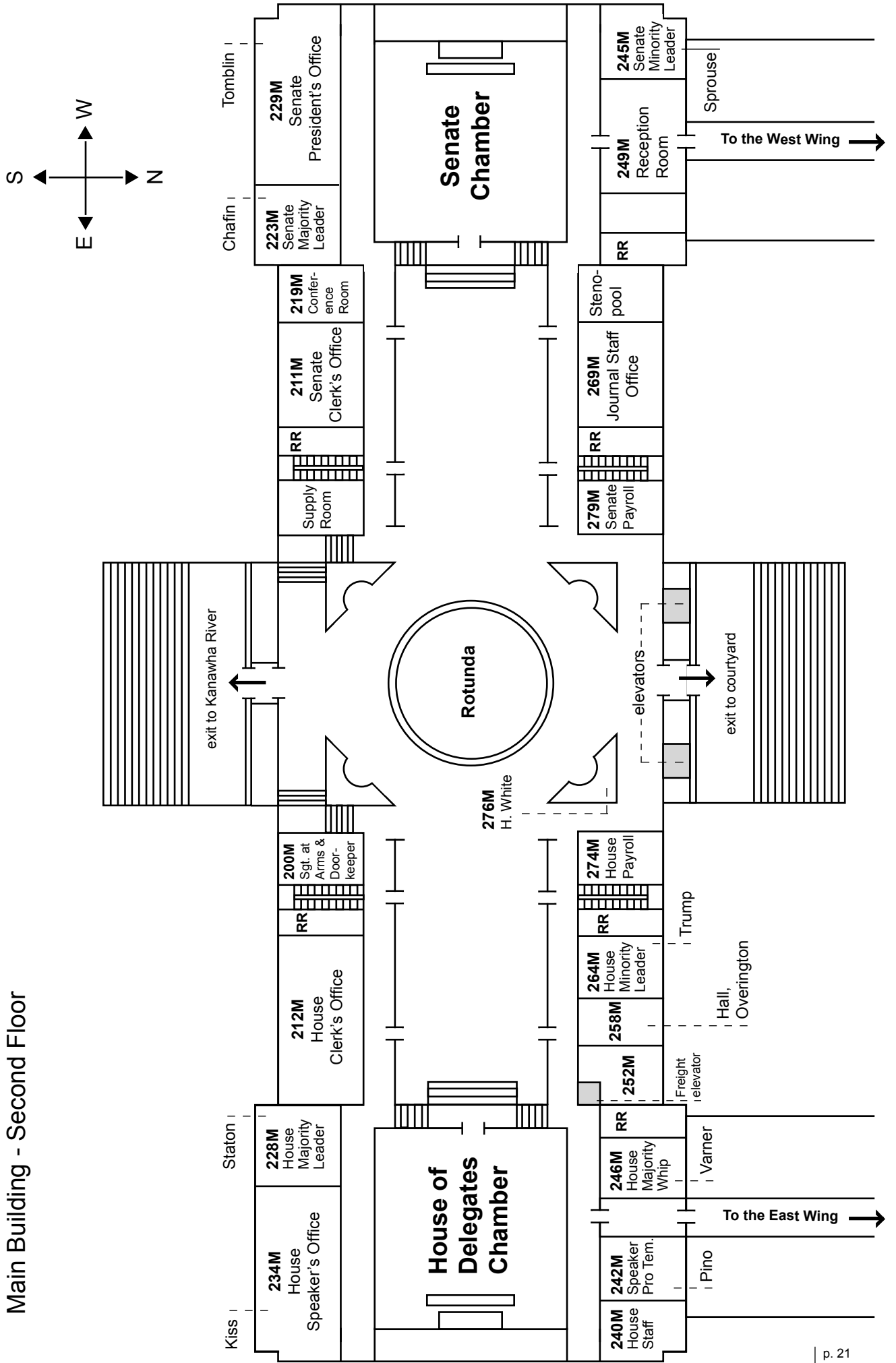

Main Building - Ground Floor



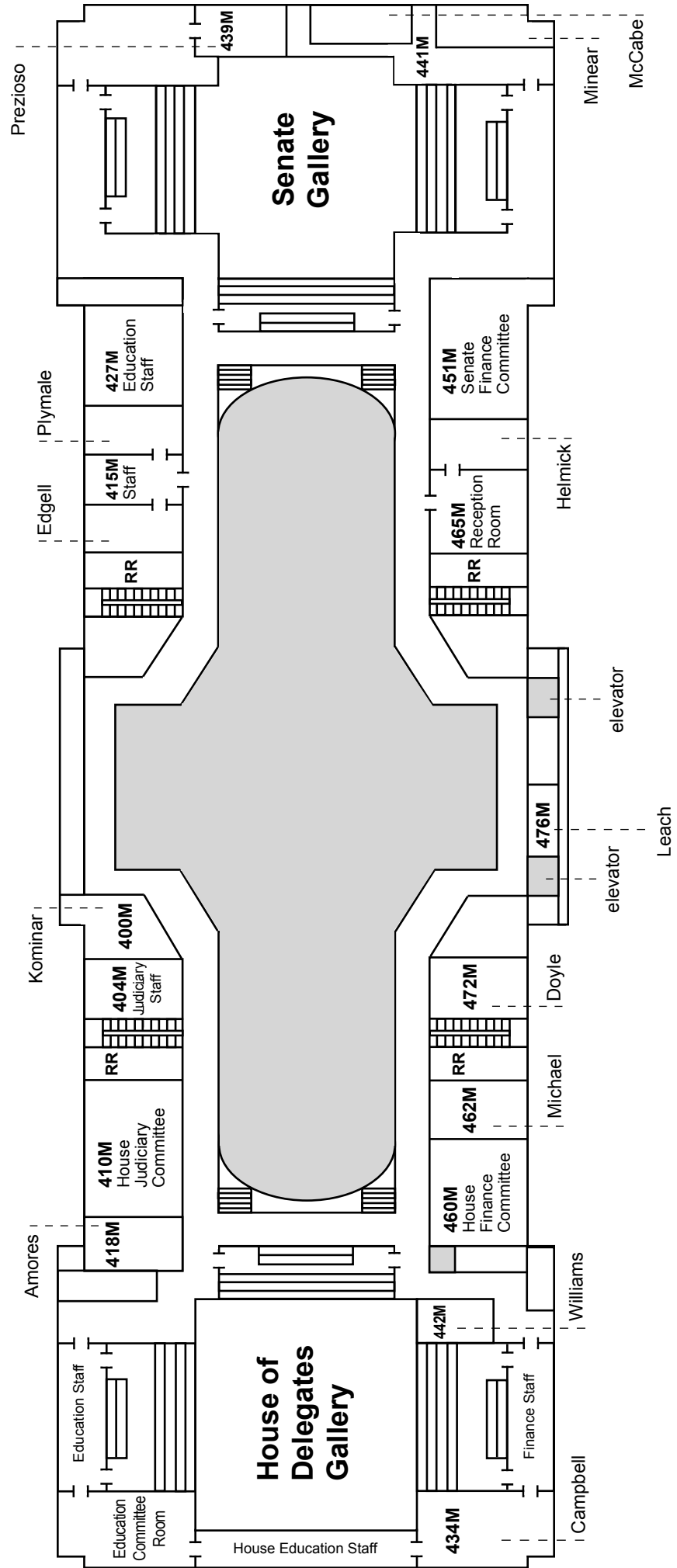
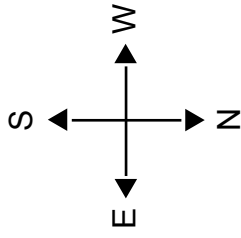

Main Building - Second Floor



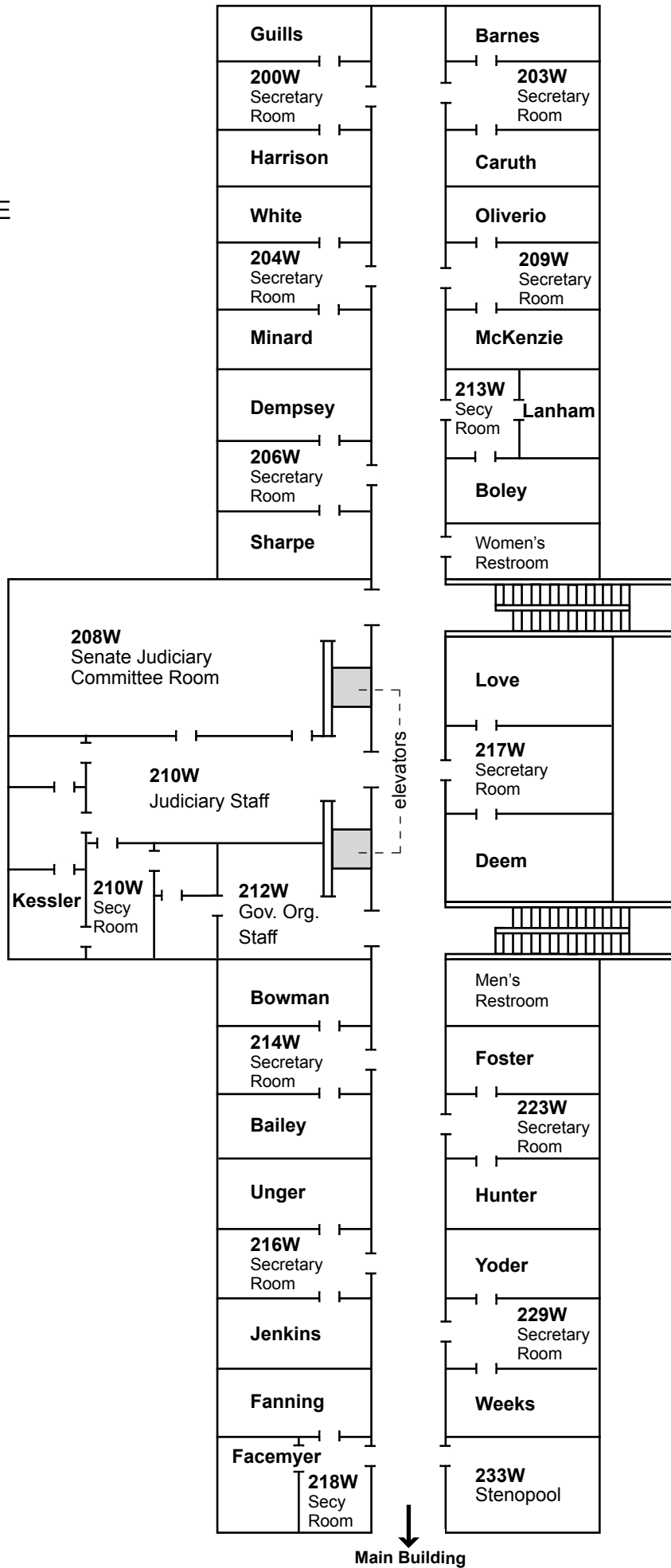
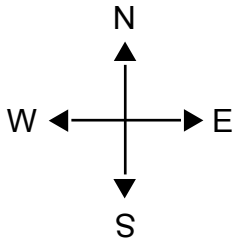

Main Building - Third Floor



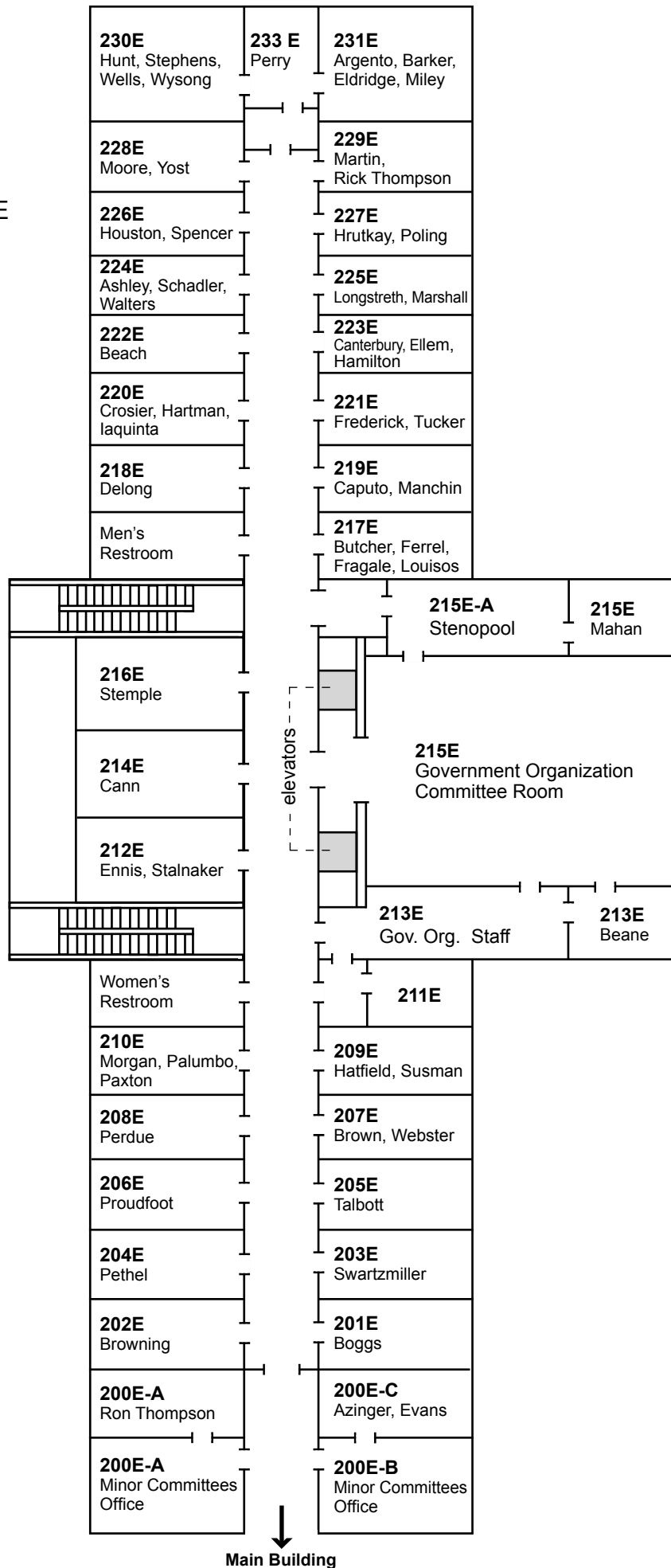
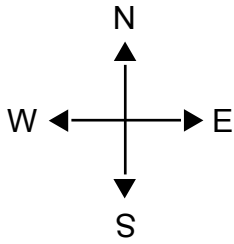

2005 LEGISLATIVE CALENDAR

Opening Day - January 12, 2005: Assemble to organize by election of officers and open and publish election returns. (WV Const. Art.VI, §18)

First Day - February 9, 2005: First day of session. (WV Const.Art.VI, §18)

Twentieth Day - February 28, 2005: Submission of Legislative Rule-Making Review bills due. (WV Code §29A-3-12)

Forty-first Day - March 21, 2005: Last day to introduce bills in Senate. Does not apply to originating or supplementary appropriation bills. (Senate Rule 14) Does not apply to Senate resolutions or concurrent resolutions.

Forty-fifth Day - March 25, 2005: Last day to introduce bills in House of Delegates. Does not apply to originating or supplementary appropriation bills. (House Rule 91a) Does not apply to House resolutions or concurrent resolutions.

Forty-seventh Day - March 27, 2005: Bills due out of committees in house of origin to ensure three full days for readings.

Fiftieth Day - March 30, 2005: Last day to consider bill on third reading in house of origin. Does not include budget or supplementary appropriation bills. (Joint Rule 5b)

Sixtieth Day - April 9, 2005: Adjournment at Midnight. (WV Const.Art.VI, §22)
