Attached hereto is a 6-page color copy of Thornton Cooper WV 100 Delegates Map No. 1 (pages 1, 2, 3, 4, 5, and 6).

On Tuesday, September 21, 2021, I finished designing and mapping this plan on the davesredistricting.org website and published that map as a "Published Map" on that website. On the afternoon of the same day, I made reference to that map during the Joint Committee's virtual public hearing for residents of Congressional District 2. However, because of technical problems, the video portion of my presentation malfunctioned and I was unable to show the map during the presentation.

Under the plan that I have mapped out, I have accomplished three separate objectives: (1) I kept the population of each of the 100 delegate districts within a variance of less 1% from the ideal figure of 17,937. (2) There are 23 counties in West Virginia each of which has a population of less than 17,937. Under my plan only 2 of those counties were split between different delegate districts. The other 21 whole counties are components of a total of 17 delegate districts. (3) Of the remaining 83 delegate districts, each one of 66 of them is located wholly within one county.

I may provide further information about this plan in the next few weeks.
