AN ACT to amend and reenact article six, chapter sixty-four of the code of West Virginia, one thousand nine hundred thirty-one, as amended, all relating generally to the promulgation of administrative rules by the various executive or administrative agencies and the procedures relating thereto; legislative mandate or authorization for the promulgation of certain legislative rules by various executive or administrative agencies of the state; authorizing certain of the agencies to promulgate certain legislative rules in the form that the rules were filed in the state register; authorizing certain of the agencies to promulgate certain legislative rules with various modifications presented to and recommended by the legislative rule-making review committee; authorizing certain of the agencies to promulgate certain legislative rules as amended by the legislature; authorizing certain of the agencies to promulgate certain legislative rules with various modifications presented to

and recommended by the legislative rule-making review committee and as amended by the legislature; authorizing the division of corrections to promulgate a legislative rule relating to parole supervision; and authorizing the division of corrections to promulgate a legislative rule relating to electronic monitoring of offenders.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:

That article six, chapter sixty-four of the code of West Virginia, one thousand nine hundred thirty-one, as amended, be amended and reenacted, to read as follows:


ARTICLE 6. AUTHORIZATION FOR DEPARTMENT OF MILITARY AFFAIRS AND PUBLIC SAFETY TO PROMULGATE LEGISLATIVE RULES.

§64-6-1. Division of corrections.

1 (a) The legislative rule filed in the state register on the first
2 day of September, two thousand, authorized under the authority
3 of section two, article thirteen, chapter sixty-two, of this code,
4 modified by the division of corrections to meet the objections
5 of the legislative rule-making review committee and refiled in
6 the state register on the twenty-fifth day of October, two
7 thousand, relating to the division of corrections (parole supervi-
8 sion, 90 CSR 2), is authorized.

9 (b) The legislative rule filed in the state register on the first
10 day of September, two thousand, authorized under the authority
11 of section fourteen, article one, chapter twenty-five, of this
12 code, modified by the division of corrections to meet the
13 objections of the legislative rule-making review committee and
14 refiled in the state register on the twenty-fifth day of October,
15 two thousand, relating to the division of corrections (electronic
16 monitoring of offenders, 90 CSR 8), is authorized.






