AN ACT to amend and reenact §29-21-3a of the Code of West Virginia, 1931, as amended, relating to continuation of Public Defender Services.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:

That §29-21-3a of the Code of West Virginia, 1931, as amended, be amended and reenacted to read as follows:

ARTICLE 21. PUBLIC DEFENDER SERVICES.

§29-21-3a. Continuation of Public Defender Services.

1 Pursuant to the provisions of article ten, chapter four of
2 this code, Public Defender Services shall continue to exist
3 until the first day of July, two thousand eight, unless
4 sooner terminated, continued or reestablished.
