AN ACT to amend and reenact §30-1-11 of the Code of West Virginia, 1931, as amended, relating to licensing boards; and prohibiting a board member from receiving compensation for travel days not on the same day as the official meeting or official duties.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:

That §30-1-11 of the Code of West Virginia, 1931, as amended, be amended and reenacted to read as follows:

ARTICLE 1. GENERAL PROVISIONS APPLICABLE TO ALL STATEBOARDS OF EXAMINATION OR REGISTRATION CREATED IN CHAPTER.

§30-1-11. Compensation of members; expenses.

- 1 (a) Each member of every board in this chapter is
- 2 entitled to receive compensation for attending official

- 3 meetings or engaging in official duties not to exceed the
- 4 amount paid to members of the Legislature for their
- 5 interim duties as recommended by the Citizens Legislative

- 9 or official duties.
- 10 (b) The limitations contained in this section do not apply
- 11 if they conflict with provisions of this chapter relating to
- 12 a particular board and enacted after the first day of
- 13 January, one thousand nine hundred ninety-five.
- 14 (c) A board may reimburse actual and necessary ex-
- 15 penses incurred for each day or portion of a day engaged
- 16 in the discharge of official duties in a manner consistent
- 17 with guidelines of the Travel Management Office of the
- 18 Department of Administration.
- 19 (d) No member of any board in this chapter may receive
- 20 compensation as an employee of the board.
