AN ACT finding and declaring certain claims against the state and its agencies to be moral obligations of the state; and directing the Auditor to issue warrants for the payment thereof.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:

#### CLAIMS AGAINST THE STATE.

§1. Finding and declaring certain claims against the Department of Health and Human Resources and Division of Corrections to be moral obligations of the state and directing payments thereof.

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The Legislature has heretofore made findings of fact 1 2 that the state has received the benefit of the 3 commodities received and/or services rendered by 4 certain claimants herein and has considered these 5 claims against the state, and agencies thereof, which 6 have arisen due to overexpenditures of the 7 departmental appropriations by officers of the state 8 spending units, the claims having been previously 9 considered by the Court of Claims which also found that 10 the state has received the benefit of the commodities 11 received and/or services rendered by the claimants, but 12 were denied by the Court of Claims on the purely 13 statutory grounds that to allow the claims would be 14 condoning illegal acts contrary to the laws of the state. 15 The Legislature, pursuant to its findings of fact and also 16 by the adoption of the findings of fact by the Court of 17 Claims as its own, while not condoning such illegal acts, 18 hereby declares it to be the moral obligation of the state to pay these claims in the amounts specified below and 19 20 directs the Auditor to issue warrants upon receipt of 21 properly executed requisitions supported by itemized 22 invoices, statements or other satisfactory documents as 23 required by section ten, article three, chapter twelve of 24 the Code of West Virginia, one thousand nine hundred 25 thirty-one, as amended, for the payments thereof out of 26 any fund appropriated and available for the purpose. 27 (a) Claims against the Department of Health and 28 Human Resources: 29 (TO BE PAID FROM GENERAL REVENUE FUND) 30 (1) Cunningham-Parker-Johnson
