- 2 (a) "Aesthetics" or "esthetics" means any one or any
- 3 combination of the following acts when done on the human body for
- 4 compensation and not for the treatment of disease:
- 5 (1) Administering cosmetic treatments to enhance or improve
- 6 the appearance of the skin, including cleansing, toning, performing
- 7 effleurage or other related movements, stimulating, exfoliating or
- 8 performing any other similar procedure on the skin of the human
- 9 body or scalp;
- 10 (2) Applying, by hand or with a mechanical or electrical
- 11 apparatus, any cosmetics, makeups, oils, powders, clays,
- 12 antiseptics, tonics, lotions, creams or chemical preparations
- 13 necessary for the practice of aesthetics to another person's face,
- 14 neck, back, shoulders, hands, elbows and feet up to and including

- 6 (j) "Certificate" means an instructor certificate to teach in 7 a school under the provisions of this article.
- 8 (k) "Certificate holder" means a person certified as an 9 instructor to teach in a school under the provisions of this 10 article.
- 11 (1) "Cosmetologist" means a person licensed under the 12 provisions of this article who engages in the practice of 13 cosmetology.
- 14 (m) "Cosmetology" means any one or any combination of the 15 following acts when done on the human body for compensation and not 16 for the treatment of disease:
- (1) Cutting, styling, shaping, arranging, braiding, weaving, 18 dressing, adding extensions, curling, waving, permanent waving, 19 relaxing, straightening, shampooing, cleansing, singeing, 20 bleaching, tinting, coloring, waxing, tweezing, or similarly work 21 on human hair, or a wig or hairpiece, by any means, including 22 hands, mechanical or electrical devices or appliances;

- 24 (3) Applying by hand or with a mechanical or electrical device

- 1 or appliance, any cosmetics, makeups, oils, powders, clays,
- 2 antiseptics, tonics, lotions, creams or chemical preparations

- 11 (n) "General supervision" means:
- 12 (1) For schools, a master or certified instructor is on the
- 13 premises and is quickly and easily available; or
- 14 (2) For salons, a professional licensee is on the premises and
- 15 is quickly and easily available.
- 16 (o) "Hair braiding" means any one or any combination of the
- 17 following acts when done on the human body for compensation and not
- 18 for the treatment of disease: Braiding, plaiting, twisting,
- 19 wrapping, threading, weaving, extending or locking of natural human
- 20 hair by hand or mechanical device.
- 21 (p) "Hair washer" means a person employed by a barber or
- 22 cosmetologist who only performs the duty of hair washing. A hair

- 8 following acts when done on the human body for compensation and not

- 10 (1) The cleansing, dressing, or polishing of nails of a 11 person;

- 13 (3) The cosmetic treatment of the feet up to the knee and the

- 15 (s) (t) "Nail technician" or "manicurist" means a person
- 16 licensed under the provisions of this article who engages in the

- 18 (t) (u) "Permit" means a work permit.
- 19 (u) (v) "Permittee" means a person holding a work permit.
- 20 $\frac{(v)}{(v)}$ "Professional license" means a license to practice as
- 21 a aesthetician, barber, barber crossover, barber permanent wavist,
- 22 cosmetologist, cosmetologist crossover or nail technician, but does
- 23 not include an apprentice license for any person employed as a hair

- 2 board to a person who rents or leases a booth or chair from a
- 3 licensed salon owner and/or operator or a registration issued by
- 4 the board to a person who is a student in a school.
- 5 $\frac{(x)}{(x)}$ (y) "Registrant" means a person who holds a registration
- 6 under the provisions of this article.
- 7 $\frac{(y)}{(z)}$ "Salon" means a shop or other facility where a person
- 8 practices under a professional license.
- 9 (z) (aa) "Salon license" means a license to own and operate a
- 10 salon.
- 11 (aa) (bb) "School" means a facility to educate persons to be
- 12 licensed with professional licenses under the provisions of this
- 13 article.
- 14 (bb) (cc) "School license" means a license to own and operate
- 15 a school.
- 16 (cc) (dd) "Student registration" means a registration issued
- 17 by the board to a student to study at a school licensed under the
- 18 provisions of this article.

NOTE: The purpose of this bill is to exempt from licensing requirements of the Board of Barbers and Cosmetologists persons who only perform the duty of hair washing for a licensed barber or cosmetologist, but requires the Board of Barbers and Cosmetologists to create an apprentice license for these persons.
