B. 2047 1 2 3 (By Delegates Butcher, Stowers, Barker and Moore) [Introduced January 12, 2011; referred to the 4 5 Committee on the Judiciary then Finance.] 6 7 8 9 10 A BILL to amend the Code of West Virginia, 1931, as amended, by 11 adding thereto a new section, designated \$29-22-9b, relating 12 to establishing a lottery scratch-off game for the benefit of 13 West Virginia firefighters; creating a fund; and providing for 14 legislative rule and expenditures from the fund. 15 Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia: That the Code of West Virginia, 1931, as amended, be amended 16 17 by adding thereto a new section, designated §29-22-9b, to read as 18 follows: 19 **ARTICLE 22.** STATE LOTTERY ACT. 20 §29-22-9b. Firefighters instant lottery scratch-off game. (a) Beginning September 1, 2011, the commission shall 21 22 establish an instant lottery scratch-off game designated as the 23 West Virginia firefighters benefit game, which is offered by the

## 1 <u>lottery</u>.

(b) Notwithstanding the provisions of section eighteen of this 2 3 article, all net profits received from the sale of the West 4 Virginia firefighters game lottery tickets, materials and games are 5 deposited with the State Treasurer into the West Virginia 6 Firefighters Game Lottery Fund created under subsection (d) of this 7 section. Funds from the West Virginia Firefighters Game Lottery 8 Fund shall be divided evenly between, and shall be used, as 9 follows: (1) As an incentive for the recruitment and retention of 10 West Virginia volunteer firefighters, to provide recognition of 11 West Virginia volunteer firefighters and to provide higher 12 education as provided herein; and (2) to enhance the municipal 13 firefighter pension and relief funds created pursuant to article 14 twenty-two, chapter eight of this code. 15 (c) The State Fire Commission shall oversee the tuition 16 reimbursement portion of the game and shall propose rules for 17 legislative approval in accordance with the provisions of article 18 three, chapter twenty-nine-a of this code for the incentive for the 19 recruitment and retention of West Virginia volunteer firefighters, 20 to provide recognition of West Virginia volunteer firefighters and 21 to provide higher education with respect to tuition. These 22 proposed rules shall provide that any West Virginia resident 23 volunteer firefighter and junior firefighter, as defined by the 24 State Fire Commission, who is an active member of a fire department

1 recognized by the State Fire Commission, may be eligible to receive 2 tuition to attend any national or state credentialed program within 3 the State of West Virginia. These rules shall provide for one 4 semester of tuition for each two years of service provided by the 5 firefighter: Provided, That tuition may not exceed \$2500 a 6 recipient: Provided, however, That a person may not receive tuition for more than three semesters under this program. These 8 proposed rules shall also require that applicants must apply in 9 advance and that they will be placed upon a list. Applicants must 10 reapply for each semester he or she seeks tuition. The proposed 11 rule shall also require an applicant applying for his or her first semester meet all requirements of the institution and that an 13 applicant applying for his or her second or third semester of 14 tuition assistance must show proof that he or she has a grade point 15 average of at least two on a scale of four. Applicants shall be 16 required to complete an application form verifying affiliation with their volunteer fire department and have the application signed by 18 the chief of the department with the chief's signature notarized. 19 (d) There is hereby created in the State Treasury a special 20 revenue fund designated and known as the West Virginia Firefighters 21 Game Fund which shall consist of all revenues derived from the West 22 Virginia firefighters game and any appropriations to the fund by 23 the Legislature and all interest or other returns earned from 24 investment of the fund. The State Treasurer shall pay out one-half

- 1 the revenues on the order of the State Fire Commission for the
- 2 incentive for the recruitment and retention of West Virginia
- 3 volunteer firefighters, to provide recognition of West Virginia
- 4 volunteer firefighters and to provide higher education with respect
- 5 to tuition. The State Treasurer shall distribute the other one
- 6 half of the revenues to the municipal firefighter pension and
- 7 relief funds created pursuant to article twenty-two, chapter eight
- 8 of this code each December, beginning with December, 2011. This
- 9 distribution shall be divided equally among each of the municipal
- 10 firefighter pension and relief funds in this state.
- 11 (e) The commission shall change the design or theme of the
- 12 West Virginia firefighters benefit game regularly so that the game
- 13 remains competitive with the other instant lottery scratch-off
- 14 games offered by the commission. The tickets for the instant
- 15 lottery game created in this section shall clearly state that the
- 16 profits derived from the game are being used to benefit
- 17 firefighters in this state.

NOTE: The purpose of this bill is to establish a lottery scratch-off game for the benefit of West Virginia firefighters for tuition to attend institutions of higher education.

\$29-22-9b is new; therefore, it has been completely underscored.
