6 (b) Beginning in December 2015 and every five years after  
7 that, the board shall submit a report to the Joint Committee on  
8 Government and Finance containing:

9 (1) The amount the maximum award amount would need to be  
10 adjusted to compensate for inflation; and

11 (2) Its recommendation, if any, addressing the amount the  
12 maximum award amount should be changed.

13 (c) After the board has made an award for a suggestion, the  
14 Governor may make one secondary award of up to twenty percent of  
15 the additional savings realized by implementing the suggestion in  
16 one or more other state agencies, not to exceed \$5,000. The  
17 Governor shall pay secondary awards from funds appropriated by the  
18 Legislature for secondary awards.

NOTE: The purpose of this bill is to:

(1) Increase the maximum cash award the Employee Suggestion Award Board may make for an individual award to \$16,000;

(2) Require the board to report to the Legislature every five years the amount the maximum award amount would need to be adjusted to compensate for inflation and give its recommendation, if any, addressing the amount the maximum award amount should be changed; and

(3) Allow the Governor to make a secondary award of up to

\$5,000 for suggestions the board has approved if the suggestion is implemented in one or more additional state agencies.
