10	A BILL to amend and reenact $\$18-2-25$ of the Code of West Virginia,
11	1931, as amended, relating to the West Virginia secondary
12	school activities commission; and requiring rules to provide
13	for use of neck braces by football players.
14	Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:
15	That \$18-2-25 of the Code of West Virginia, 1931, as amended,
16	be amended and reenacted to read as follows:
17	ARTICLE 2. STATE BOARD OF EDUCATION.
18	§18-2-25. Authority of county boards to regulate athletic and
19	other extracurricular activities of secondary
20	schools; delegation of authority to West Virginia
21	Secondary School Activities Commission; authority of
22	commission; approval of rules by state board;
23	incorporation; funds; participation by private and
24	parochial schools.

The county boards of education are hereby granted and shall exercise the control, supervision and regulation of all interscholastic athletic events, and other extracurricular activities of the students in public secondary schools, and of said the schools of their respective counties. The county board of education may delegate such control, supervision and regulation of interscholastic athletic events and band activities to the "West Virginia Secondary School Activities Commission," which is hereby established.

10 The West Virginia Secondary School Activities Commission shall 11 be composed of the principals, or their representatives, of those 12 secondary schools whose county boards of education have certified 13 in writing to the State Superintendent of Schools that they have 14 elected to delegate the control, supervision and regulation 15 their interscholastic athletic events and band activities of the 16 students in the public secondary schools in their 17 counties to said commission. The West Virginia Secondary School 18 Activities Comission, is hereby empowered to exercise the control, 19 supervision and regulation of interscholastic athletic events and 20 band activities of secondary schools, delegated to it pursuant to 21 this section. The rules and regulations of the West Virginia 22 Secondary School Activities Commission shall contain a provision 23 for a proper review procedure and review board and be promulgated 24 in accordance with the provisions of chapter twenty-nine-a of this

1 code, but shall, in all instances be subject to the prior approval 2 of the state board. The West Virginia Secondary School Activities 3 Commission, may, with the consent of the State Board of Education, 4 incorporate under the name of "West Virginia Secondary School 5 Activities Commission, Inc.," as a nonprofit, nonstock corporation 6 under the provisions of chapter thirty-one of this code. 7commission shall provide in any rule pertaining to interscholastic 8 athletic football events that all players are required to wear neck 9 braces, in addition to the head gear and other protective equipment 10 ordinarily worn in those events. County boards of education are 11 hereby authorized to expend moneys for and pay dues to the West 12 Virginia Secondary School Activities Commission, and all moneys 13 paid to such the commission, as well as moneys derived from any 14 contest or other event sponsored by said commission, shall be 15 quasi-public funds as the same are defined in article five, chapter 16 eighteen, and such the funds of the commission shall be subject to 17 an annual audit by the State Tax Commissioner.

The West Virginia Secondary School Activities Commission shall 19 promulgate reasonable rules and regulations providing for the 20control, supervision and regulation of the interscholastic athletic 21 events and other extracurricular activities of such the private and 22 parochial secondary schools as elect to delegate to such the 23commission such control, supervision and regulation, upon the same 24 terms and conditions, subject to the same regulations and

1 requirements and upon the payment of the same fees and charges as 2 those provided for public secondary schools. Any such private or 3 parochial secondary school shall receive any monetary or other 4 benefits in the same manner and in the same proportion as any 5public secondary school.

NOTE: The purpose of this bill is to require the West Virginia Secondary School Activities Commission to adopt rules to provide for use of neck braces by football players in interscholastic athletic football events.
