

**H. B. 2125**

A BILL to amend the Code of West Virginia, 1931, as amended, by  
adding thereto a new section, designated §35-5-9, relating to  
requiring every interment or grave to identify the decedents'  
identity.

*Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:*

That the Code of West Virginia, 1931, as amended, be amended  
by adding thereto a new section, designated §35-5-9, to read as  
follows:

**ARTICLE 5. CEMETERIES.**

**§35-5-9. Names on internments or graves required.**

From the effective date of this section, every interment or  
grave shall have a name plate identifying the decedents' identity.

NOTE: The purpose of this bill is to require every interment

or grave to identify the decedents' identity.

This section is new; therefore, it has been completely underscored.
