

1 (b) Before posting notice of an opening in any regular full-
2 time or regular part-time central office administrator position of
3 employment other than county superintendent, the county board shall
4 determine the feasibility of obtaining the needed administrative
5 services from the county board's regional education service agency
6 and of sharing the services of administrators with the county
7 boards of contiguous counties. The determination shall be in
8 writing and contain supporting reasons.

9 (c) Where a county obtains central office administrative
10 services from its regional education service agency, or where two
11 or more counties join together to share the services of central
12 office administrative personnel, any employee whose services are no
13 longer needed by virtue of ~~such~~ the sharing of these services or
14 the use of these services provided by a regional education service
15 agency may have his or her contract terminated for lack of need, as
16 provided in sections two and six, article two of this chapter,
17 notwithstanding any provision of this code to the contrary. Any
18 employee whose contract is so terminated shall be afforded all
19 rights pursuant to the provisions of section eight-b of this
20 article.

NOTE: The purpose of this bill is to authorize and encourage county boards of education to share services of central office administrative personnel and to obtain these services from regional education service agencies.
