1in rooms that have been designated or set aside for2use by handicapped or disabled patrons.3Any hotel and motel room in this state that is designated or4held out to be handicapped accessible or intended for use by5patrons with disabilities shall, at a minimum, include grab bars6installed on each wall of the tub or shower which meet the7Americans with Disabilities Act of 1990 design standards8established by 28 CFR Part 36 (1991), or any successor regulation9established by the Department of Justice or its successor.

NOTE: The purpose of this bill is to provide for the maintenance of sufficient grab bars in hotel and motel rooms which have been set aside or designated to serve the needs of disabled patrons, to reduce the prospect of injury caused by falls in tubs and showers.
