

1 The state board shall study, evaluate and determine all
2 reports required to be generated by principals and teachers to
3 determine those reports that are unduly burdensome, repetitive,
4 unnecessary, counterproductive or outdated in effort to alleviate
5 the administrative burden on principals and teachers.

6 The state board shall identify any such reports, together with
7 any comments and recommendations on how to reduce or consolidate
8 these reports, to the Legislative Oversight Commission on Education
9 Accountability, no later than December 31 of each year.

NOTE: The purpose of this bill is to direct the State Board of Education to determine what principal and teacher reports are unnecessary; and to require the state board to identify these reports to the Legislature with recommendations on how to alleviate the administrative burden of these reports on principals and teachers.
