13	Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:
14	That the Code of West Virginia, 1931, as amended, be amended
15	by adding thereto a new section, designated \$18C-3-1a, to read as
16	follows:
17	ARTICLE 3. HEALTH PROFESSIONALS STUDENT LOAN PROGRAMS.
18	§18C-3-1a. Nursing education loan program; administration;
19	eligibility and loan cancellation; required report.
20	(a) For the purposes of this section, vice chancellor of
21	administration means the person employed pursuant to section two,
22	article four, chapter eighteen-b of this code.
23	(b) There is hereby created a Special Revolving Fund account

- 1 under the commission in the State Treasury to be known as the
- 2 Nursing Education Student Loan Fund which shall be used to carry
- 3 out the purposes of this section. The fund consists of:
- 4 (1) Appropriations provided by the Legislature;
- 5 (2) Repayment of any loans made under this section;
- 6 (3) Amounts provided by nursing associations, hospitals, or
- 7 other medical provider organizations in this state, or by political
- 8 subdivisions of the state, under an agreement which requires the
- 9 recipient to practice his or her nursing profession in the
- 10 political subdivision providing the funds, or otherwise in this
- 11 state, for a predetermined period of time; and
- 12 (4) Other amounts available from external sources.
- Balances remaining in the fund at the end of the fiscal year
- 14 do not expire or revert. All costs associated with administering
- 15 this section shall be paid from the Nursing Education Student Loan
- 16 Fund.
- 17 <u>(c) The vice chancellor for administration may utilize any</u>
- 18 funds in the Health Education Student Loan Fund for the purposes of
- 19 the nursing student loan program. The commission shall determine
- 20 and give priority for the loans to residents of this state. An
- 21 individual is eligible for loan consideration upon:
- 22 (1) Demonstrating financial need;
- 23 (2) Meeting established academic standards;
- 24 (3) Is enrolled or accepted for enrollment in an accredited

- 1 institution of higher education in this state in a program leading
- 2 to the degree of licensed practical nurse or registered nurse;
- 3 (4) Not yet receiving one of the degrees provided in
- 4 subdivision (3) of this subsection; and
- 5 (5) Not defaulting on any previous student loan.
- 6 (d) At the end of each fiscal year, any individual who has
- 7 received a nursing student loan and rendered services as a licensed
- 8 practical nurse or registered nurse in this state in a medically
- 9 underserved area or in a nursing specialty in which there is a
- 10 shortage of qualified nurses, as determined by the Division of
- 11 Health at the time the loan was granted, may submit to the
- 12 commission a notarized, sworn statement of service on a form
- 13 provided for that purpose. Upon receipt of the statement the
- 14 commission shall cancel \$5,000 of the outstanding loan or loans for
- 15 every full twelve consecutive calendar months of such service.
- 16 (e) No later than thirty days following the end of each fiscal
- 17 year, the vice chancellor for administration shall prepare and
- 18 submit a report to the commission for inclusion in the statewide
- 19 report card required under section eight, article one-b, chapter
- 20 eighteen-b to be submitted to the Legislative Oversight Commission
- 21 on Education Accountability established under section eleven,
- 22 article three-a of chapter twenty-nine-a of this code. At a
- 23 minimum, the report shall include the following information:
- 24 (1) The number of loans awarded;

- 1 (2) The total amount of the loans awarded;
- 2 (3) The amount of any unexpended moneys in the fund; and
- 3 (4) The rate of default during the previous fiscal year on the
- 4 repayment of loans granted pursuant to this section.

NOTE: The purpose of this bill is to provide a loan forgiveness program for nurses similar to what currently exists for medical doctors and osteopathic physicians.

This section is new; therefore, it has been completely underscored.
