10 A BILL to amend and reenact §60-2-12 of the Code of West Virginia,
11 1931, as amended, relating to providing that enforcement
12 officers employed by the office of West Virginia Alcohol
13 Beverage Control Commissioner be included in the classified
14 service under the Civil Service System.

15 *Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:*

16 That §60-2-12 of the Code of West Virginia, 1931, as amended,
17 be amended and reenacted to read as follows:

18 **ARTICLE 2. ALCOHOL BEVERAGE CONTROL COMMISSIONER.**

19 **§60-2-12. Assistants and employees.**

20 The commission shall appoint or employ such assistants and
21 employees as may be necessary to the efficient operation of the
22 department and fix their salaries. All assistants and employees
23 shall be appointed or employed to serve during the will and
24 pleasure of the commission: Provided, That effective July 1, 2011,
25 persons employed as enforcement agents shall be included in the
26 classified service under the Civil Service System.

NOTE: The purpose of this bill is to provide that enforcement officers employed by the office of West Virginia Alcohol Beverage Control Commissioner be included in the classified service under the Civil Service System.

Strike-throughs indicate language that would be stricken from the present law, and underscoring indicates new language that would be added.
