L 4	rental fees for elderly and disabled persons is applicable

L 6	Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:
L 7	That $\$20-5-18$ and $\$20-5-19$ of the Code of West Virginia, 1931,
L 8	as amended, be amended and reenacted, all to read as follows:
L 9	ARTICLE 5. PARKS AND RECREATION.
20	§20-5-18. Discounts for West Virginia residents over the age of
21	sixty-two.
22	The director shall provide to West Virginia citizens who are
23	sixty-two years of age or older, and who document residency and age
24	by a valid West Virginia driver's license, a fifty percent
25	reduction in campground rental fees for each campsite to be used

- 1 exclusively by said the eligible camper. Provided, That the fifty
- 2 percent reduction in campground rental fees shall only apply to
- 3 those rentals occurring during the period of time beginning on the
- 4 day after Labor Day and ending four days prior to Memorial day.
- 5 §20-5-19. Discounts for West Virginia residents who are totally
- 6 and permanently disabled.
- 7 The director shall issue a discount card to West Virginia
- 8 residents who are totally and permanently disabled which would
- 9 provide a fifty percent reduction in campground rental fees for
- 10 each campsite to be used exclusively by the eligible camper:
- 11 Provided, That in order to be eligible for the reduction, the
- 12 person shall document that he or she is a resident of this state
- 13 and that he or she has a total and permanent disability. The
- 14 director shall promulgate rules in accordance with article three,
- 15 chapter twenty-nine twenty-nine-a of this code setting forth the
- 16 documentation which is necessary to prove residency and total and
- 17 permanent disability. Provided, however, That the fifty percent
- 18 reduction in campground rental fees applies only to those rentals
- 19 occurring during the period of time beginning on the day after
- 20 Labor Day and ending four days prior to Memorial Day.

NOTE: The purpose of this bill is to provide that the fifty percent reduction for campground rental fees for elderly and disabled persons at state parks is applicable throughout the year.
