10	A BILL to amend of the Code of West Virginia, 1931, as amended, by
11	adding thereto a new section, designated $\$61-2-31$ , relating to
12	railroad employees; and establishing criminal penalties for
13	interfering with medical treatment of a railroad employee
14	injured during the course of employment.
15	Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:
16	That the Code of West Virginia, 1931, as amended, be amended
17	by adding thereto a new section, designated §61-2-31, to read as
18	follows:
19	ARTICLE 2. CRIMES AGAINST THE PERSON.
20	§61-2-31. Interference with treatment of injured railroad employee.
21	(a) It is unlawful for a railroad company or person employed
22	by a railroad company to:
23	(1) Deny, delay or interfere with medical treatment or first
24	aid treatment to an employee of a railroad company who has been
25	injured during employment; or

- 1 (2) Discipline or threaten discipline to an employee of a
- 2 railroad company who has been injured during employment for
- 3 requesting medical treatment or first aid treatment for the injury.
- 4 (b) A railroad company who violates the provisions of this
- 5 section is guilty of a misdemeanor and, upon conviction thereof,
- 6 shall be fined not more than \$10,000 for each violation. A person
- 7 who violates the provisions of this section is guilty of a
- 8 misdemeanor and, upon conviction thereof, shall be fined not more
- 9 than \$10,000 or confined in jail for no more than one year, or both
- 10 fined and confined.

NOTE: The purpose of this bill is to create criminal penalties for a railroad company or employee who denies, delays or interferes with medical treatment or first aid to a railroad employee injured on the job, or who threatens discipline to an injured employee who requests medical treatment or first aid for a job injury.

This section is new; therefore, it has been completely underscored.
