10 A BILL to extend the time for the Board of Education of Upshur  
11 County, West Virginia, to meet as a levying body for the  
12 purpose of submitting to the voters of that county an election  
13 on the question of the approval of a special levy for the  
14 payment of principal and interest on bond indebtedness  
15 authorized pursuant to Section 10, Article X of the West  
16 Virginia Constitution until the last day in May, 2011, that is  
17 not a Saturday, Sunday or legal holiday.

18 *Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:*

19 **§1. Extending the time for the Board of Education of Upshur County**  
20 **to meet as levying body for election to consider the question**  
21 **of a bond levy.**

22 Notwithstanding the provisions of article eight, chapter  
23 eleven of the Code of West Virginia, 1931, as amended, to the  
24 contrary, the Board of Education of Upshur County, West Virginia,

1 is authorized to extend the time for its meeting as a levying body,  
2 setting the levying rate and certifying its actions to the Auditor  
3 until the last day in May, 2011, that is not a Saturday, Sunday or  
4 legal holiday, for the purpose of submitting to the voters of that  
5 county an election on the question of the approval of a special  
6 levy for the payment of principal and interest on bond indebtedness  
7 authorized pursuant to Section 10, Article X of the West Virginia  
8 Constitution.

NOTE: The purpose of this bill is to extend the time for the Board of Education of Upshur County to meet as a levying body to present to the voters of Upshur County the question of a bond levy.

This section is new; therefore, it has been completely underscored.
