10 A BILL to amend and reenact article 5, chapter 64 of the Code of
11 West Virginia, 1931, as amended, relating to authorizing the
12 Department of Health and Human Resources to promulgate a
13 legislative rule relating to the requirements for licensure of
14 nonprofit corporations for conservator service.

15 *Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:*

16 That article 5, chapter 64 of the Code of West Virginia, 1931,
17 as amended, be amended and reenacted to read as follows:

18 **ARTICLE 5. AUTHORIZATION FOR DEPARTMENT OF HEALTH AND HUMAN**
19 **RESOURCES TO PROMULGATE LEGISLATIVE RULES.**

20 **§64-5-1. Department of Health and Human Resources.**

21 The legislative rule filed in the state register on the
22 thirtieth day of July, two thousand ten, authorized under the
23 authority of section eight, article one, chapter forty-four-a, of
24 this code, modified by the Department of Health and Human Resources
25 to meet the objections of the Legislative Rule-Making Review

1 Committee and refiled in the state register on the third day of
2 December, two thousand ten, relating to the Department of Health
3 and Human Resources (requirements for licensure of nonprofit
4 corporations for conservator service, 64 CSR 99), is authorized.

6 NOTE: The purpose of this bill is to authorize the Department
7 of Health and Human Resources to promulgate a legislative rule
8 relating to the Requirements for Licensure of Nonprofit
9 Corporations for Conservator Service.
