10 A BILL to amend and reenact article 10, chapter 64 of the Code of  
11 West Virginia, 1931, as amended, relating to the supervision  
12 of elevator mechanics and apprentices.

13 *Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:*

14 That article 10, chapter 64 of the Code of West Virginia,  
15 1931, as amended, be amended and reenacted to read as follows:

16 **ARTICLE 10. AUTHORIZATION FOR BUREAU OF COMMERCE TO PROMULGATE**  
17 **LEGISLATIVE RULES.**

18 **§64-10-1. Division of Labor.**

19 The legislative rule filed in the state register on the  
20 thirtieth day of July, two thousand ten, authorized under the  
21 authority of section eleven, article three-c, chapter twenty-one,  
22 of this code, modified by the Division of Labor to meet the  
23 objections of the Legislative Rule-Making Review Committee and  
24 refiled in the state register on the twenty-third day of September,  
25 two thousand ten, relating to the Division of Labor (supervision of

1 elevator mechanics and apprentices, 42 CSR 21A), is authorized.

3 NOTE: The purpose of this bill is to authorize the Division of  
4 Labor to promulgate a legislative rule relating to the Supervision  
5 of Elevator Mechanics and Apprentices.
