16 A BILL to amend and reenact article 9, chapter 64 of the Code of
17 West Virginia, 1931, as amended, relating to authorizing the
18 Board of Optometry to promulgate a legislative rule relating
19 to rules of the Board.

20 *Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:*

21 That article 9, chapter 64 of the Code of West Virginia, 1931,
22 as amended, be amended and reenacted to read as follows:

23 **ARTICLE 9. AUTHORIZATION FOR MISCELLANEOUS AGENCIES AND BOARDS TO**
24 **PROMULGATE LEGISLATIVE RULES.**

25 **§64-9-1. Board of Optometry.**

1 The legislative rule filed in the state register on the
2 thirtieth day of July, two thousand ten, authorized under the
3 authority of section six, article eight, chapter thirty, of this
4 code, modified by the Board of Optometry to meet the objections of
5 the Legislative Rule-Making Review Committee and refiled in the
6 state register on the twenty-fourth day of November, two thousand
7 ten, relating to the Board of Optometry (rules of the West Virginia
8 Board of Optometry, 14 CSR 1), is authorized.

10 NOTE: The purpose of this bill is to authorize the Board of
11 Optometry to promulgate a legislative rule relating to Rules of the
12 Board.
