10 A BILL to amend and reenact article 9, chapter 64 of the Code of
11 West Virginia, 1931, as amended, relating to authorizing the
12 Board of Optometry to promulgate a legislative rule relating
13 to contact lenses that contain and deliver pharmaceutical
14 agents certificates.

15 *Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:*

16 That article 9, chapter 64 of the Code of West Virginia, 1931,
17 as amended, be amended and reenacted to read as follows:

18 **ARTICLE 9. AUTHORIZATION FOR MISCELLANEOUS AGENCIES AND BOARDS TO**
19 **PROMULGATE LEGISLATIVE RULES.**

20 **§64-9-1. Board of Optometry.**

21 The legislative rule filed in the state register on the
22 thirtieth day of July, two thousand ten, authorized under the
23 authority of section six, article eight, chapter thirty, of this
24 code, modified by the Board of Optometry to meet the objections of
25 the Legislative Rule-Making Review Committee and refiled in the

1 state register on the twenty-fourth day of November, two thousand
2 ten, relating to the Board of Optometry (contact lenses that
3 contain and deliver pharmaceutical agents certificates, 14 CSR 9),
4 is authorized.

6 NOTE: The purpose of this bill is to authorize the Board of
7 Optometry to promulgate a legislative rule relating to Contact
8 Lenses That Contain and Deliver Pharmaceutical Agents Certificates.
