11	adding thereto a new section, designated §20-5-19a, relating

15	Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:
16	That the Code of West Virginia, 1931, as amended, be amended
17	by adding thereto a new section, designated \$20-5-19a, to read as
18	follows:
19	ARTICLE 5. PARKS AND RECREATION.
20	§20-5-19a. Discounts for disabled veterans.
21	All disabled veterans are exempt from campground rental fees
22	for each campsite to be used exclusively by the eligible camper:
23	Provided, That in order to be eligible for the exemption, the
24	person shall document that he or she is a disabled veteran. The
25	director shall promulgate rules in accordance with article three,

- 1 chapter twenty-nine-a of this code setting forth the documentation
- 2 which is necessary to prove residency and total and permanent
- 3 disability: Provided, however, That the exemption in campground
- 4 rental fees applies only to those rentals occurring during the
- 5 period of time beginning on the day after Labor Day and ending four
- 6 days prior to Memorial Day.

NOTE: The purpose of this bill is to exempt disabled veterans from campground rental fees from the day after Labor day until four days prior to Memorial Day.
