10 A BILL to amend the Code of West Virginia, 1931, as amended, by  
11 adding thereto a new section, designated §29-22-30, relating  
12 to prohibiting the lottery from using minors in advertising  
13 during school hours.

14 *Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:*

15 That the Code of West Virginia, 1931, as amended, be amended  
16 by adding thereto a new section, designated §29-22-30, to read as  
17 follows:

18 **ARTICLE 22. STATE LOTTERY ACT.**

19 **§29-22-30. Prohibited acts, advertising involving minors.**

20 The commissioners, the director, the deputy directors and the  
21 employees or any agent retained by the lottery, may not remove any  
22 minor children from the classroom during school hours or depict any  
23 public school facility for any purpose to create advertisements in  
24 any medium.

NOTE: The purpose of this bill is to prohibit the use of

minors during school time by the lottery for lottery advertisements.
