| 22 | If any person transports a minor across state lines to obtain |
| 23 | an abortion, without the written consent of both parents or the |

- 1 legal guardians of the minor, the person is guilty of a misdemeanor
- 2 and, upon conviction thereof, shall be fined not less than \$500 nor
- 3 more than \$1,000, or confined in jail not more than six months, or
- 4 both fined and confined.

NOTE: The purpose of this bill is to make it illegal to transport a minor across state lines to obtain an abortion without written consent by both parents, or the legal guardians of the minor; and providing for a penalty.
