15	Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:
16	That the Code of West Virginia, 1931, as amended, be amended

20	§15-2-53. Waiver or reimbursement of tuition and fees for members

23	(a) Any member of the State Police who is enrolled in a course
24	of undergraduate or graduate study and is attending an accredited
25	college or university that is a state-supported school located in

1 West Virginia shall receive a waiver of tuition and fees from that
2 college or university during the period of his or her service in
3 the State Police.

4 (b) Any member of the State Police who is enrolled in a course 5 of undergraduate or graduate study and is attending an accredited 6 college or university that is a private school located in West 7 Virginia shall receive reimbursement for tuition and fees incurred 8 at that college or university during the period of his or her 9 service in the State Police in an amount to be determined by the 10 superintendent, but which may not exceed the highest tuition and 11 fees payable at any state-supported school. 12 (c) The superintendent shall propose rules for legislative 13 approval in accordance with the provisions of article three,

14 <u>chapter twenty-nine-a of this code to prescribe eligibility</u>

15 criteria for a tuition and fees waiver or reimbursement, and to

16 otherwise implement the provisions of this section.

NOTE: The purpose of this bill is to provide for a waiver or reimbursement of tuition and fees for members of the West Virginia State Police attending institutions of higher education.
