20	§25-1-1b. Commissioner required to keep track of recidivism of

22	In addition to those duties prescribed to the commissioner,
23	the commissioner shall keep a record of convictions of repeat
24	sexual offenses committed by convicted child sex offenders who
25	reside in this state. At a minimum, the record shall include the

1 <u>name and address of the offender, the date of the offender's first</u>
2 <u>conviction for a sexual offense committed against a child and all</u>
3 <u>subsequent offenses which result in a conviction. The commissioner</u>
4 <u>shall propose rules for legislative approval in accordance with the</u>

NOTE: The purpose of this bill is to require the Commissioner of Corrections to keep track of repeat offenses committed by persons convicted of sexual offenses against children.
