18	§20-7-22. General rules and regulations for motorboating; special

20	The director is hereby authorized and empowered to <u>may</u>

22	(a) General rules and regulations to be observed in the
23	operation or navigation of motorboats upon, over or through the
24	waters of this state which he or she shall deem determines
