10	A BILL to amend the Code of West Virginia, 1931, as amended, by
11	adding thereto a new section, designated $15-2-5a$ , relating to
12	West Virginia State Police receiving on-call and off-duty pay;
13	providing for the State Police to be paid minimum wage for
14	every hour on-call; and guaranteeing a minimum of two hours
15	pay to State Police when called to duty off hours.
16	Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:
17	That the Code of West Virginia, 1931, as amended, by adding
18	thereto a new section, designated §15-2-5a, to read as follows:
19	ARTICLE 2. WEST VIRGINIA STATE POLICE.
20	<u>§15-2-5a. On-call and off-duty compensation.</u>
21	(a) When any member of the West Virginia State Police is
22	required to be on-call during off-duty hours and the activities of
23	that member are restricted during the on-call time period to allow
24	rapid response to a call, that member shall be paid the minimum
25	wage as determined in section two, article five-c, chapter twenty-

1 <u>one of this code for every hour which he or she is on call. This</u>
2 <u>section applies only to those nonexempt members as defined under</u>
3 <u>the Fair Labor Standards Act, pursuant to 29 U.S.C. §213. This on-</u>
4 <u>call pay is not subject to retirement deduction, and may not be</u>
5 <u>included in retirement annuity calculations. The on-call pay shall</u>
6 <u>only be for the hours on-call and not for any time periods the</u>
7 <u>member is called back to work.</u>
8 <u>(b) Members who are off-duty and called back to work shall be</u>
9 guaranteed a minimum of two hours' work or actual hours worked,

10 whichever is greater.

NOTE: The purpose of this bill is to provide that West Virginia State Police receiving on-call and off-duty pay be paid minimum wage for every hour on-call. It also guarantees a minimum of two hours pay to state police when called to duty off hours.
