10	A BILL to amend the Code of West Virginia, 1931, as amended, by
11	adding thereto a new article, designated §5A-6B-1, §5A-6B-2,
12	SA-6B-3, $SA-6B-4$ and $SA-6B-5$ , all relating to the West
13	Virginia Geographical Information System.
14	Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:
15	That the Code of West Virginia, 1931, as amended, be amended
16	by adding thereto a new article, designated §5A-6B-1, §5A-6B-2,
17	S5A-6B-3, $S5A-6B-4$ and $S5A-6B-5$ , all to read as follows:
18	ARTICLE 6B. WEST VIRGINIA GEOGRAPHICAL INFORMATION SYSTEM.
19	<u>§5A-6B-1. Findings.</u>
20	(a) The Legislature finds that computerized geographical
21	information systems technology and the management and sharing of
22	information about the state's natural and cultural resources is
23	essential to finding practical solutions to good, efficient and
24	effective governance.
25	(b) The Legislature further finds that Executive Order 4-93
26	provided for:

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(1) The West Virginia Geographical Information System Policy 1 2 Council to oversee the implementation of the state GIS Development 3 Plan; (2) The appointment of the state GIS Coordinator; 4 5 (3) The appointment of a steering committee to coordinate the 6 technical aspects of the plan; 7 (4) The development of a GIS Users Group to educate, train and 8 exchange information among GIS users; and (5) The creation of a GIS Technical Center in cooperation with 9 10 West Virginia University. 11 §5A-6B-2. Definitions. (a) "Chief Technology Officer" means the person defined in 12 13 article six, chapter five-a of this code. 14 (b) "Geological and Economic Survey" means the entity provided 15 in article two, chapter twenty-nine of this code. 16 (c) "Geospatial" means a combination of spatial software and 17 analytical methods of terrestrial or geographic datasets. 18 (d) "GIS Plan" means the Geographical Information System Plan. 19 (e) "GIS Technical Center" means the state GIS Technical 20 Center in the Department of Geology and Geography at West Virginia 21 University. 22 (f) "GIS Users Group" includes the West Virginia Association 23 of Geospatial Professional and other groups or individuals that 24 educate, train and exchange information among GIS users.

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1	§5A-6B-3. Development of GIS Plan; report to Governor and
2	Legislature.
3	(a) The following offices, individuals and groups of
4	individuals are recognized to assist the development of the state
5	Geographic Information System Plan:
6	(1) The Chief Technology Officer;
7	(2) The Office of the state GIS Coordinator;
8	(3) The Office of the state Geological and Economic Survey;
9	(4) The West Virginia Geographical System Information Policy
10	Council; and
11	(5) GIS Users Groups including, but not limited to, the Nick
12	J. Rahall Appalachian Transportation Institute at Marshall
13	University and the West Virginia Association of Geospatial
14	Professionals.
15	(b) The state GIS Coordinator shall submit electronic annual
16	reports to the Governor and all members of the Legislature, on the
17	organizational design and administrative development and
18	implementation of the plan, including database development; system
19	and application development; system utilization, marketing and
20	coordination with outside organizations; utility infrastructure
21	<pre>mapping; inventory of assets; technology improvement initiatives;</pre>
22	reports of workgroups; and budget and funding strategies for state
23	and local governments.

24 §5A-6B-4. Security of government information.

The Chief Technology Officer shall ensure the security of all government information and the data communications infrastructure from unauthorized uses, intrusions or other security threats. **5** Free statewide GIS Coordinator in consultation with the Chief Technology Officer shall propose rules for legislative approval, in accordance with the provisions of article three, chapter twentynine-a of this code, to effectuate the provisions of this article.

NOTE: The purpose of this bill is to recognize GIS User Groups such as the West Virginia Association of Geospatial Professionals to assist the development of the state GIS Plan.
