10	A BILL to amend and reenact \$17C-7-9 of the Code of West Virginia,
11	1931, as amended, relating to the limiting the maximum
12	distance a vehicle can drive in a center lane which is clearly
13	marked as a left turn lane.
14	Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:
15	That \$17C-7-9 of the Code of West Virginia, 1931, as amended,
16	be amended and reenacted to read as follows:
17	ARTICLE 7. DRIVING ON THE RIGHT SIDE OF THE ROADWAY, OVERTAKING
18	AND PASSING, ETC.
19	§17C-7-9. Driving on roadways laned for traffic; penalty.
20	(a) Whenever any roadway has been divided into two or more
21	clearly marked lanes for traffic the following rules in addition to
22	all others consistent herewith shall apply:
23	(1) A vehicle shall be driven as nearly as practicable
24	entirely within a single lane and shall not be moved from such lane

1 until the driver has first ascertained that such movement can be 2 made with safety.

- 3 (2) Upon a roadway which is divided into three lanes a vehicle
  4 shall not be driven in the center lane which is clearly marked as
  5 a left turn lane except in preparation for a left turn, in which
  6 case a vehicle may not travel in the center lane a distance in
  7 excess of seventy-five feet, or where such center lane is at the
  8 time allocated exclusively to traffic moving in the direction the
  9 vehicle is proceeding and is signposted to give notice of such
  10 allocation.
- 11 (3) Official signs may be erected directing slow-moving 12 traffic to use a designated lane or designating those lanes to be 13 used by traffic moving in a particular direction regardless of the 14 center of the roadway and drivers of vehicles shall obey the 15 directions of every such sign.
- (b) Any person violating the provisions of this section is 17 guilty of a misdemeanor and, upon conviction thereof, shall be 18 fined not more than \$100; upon a second conviction within one year 19 thereafter, shall be fined not more than \$200; and upon a third or 20 subsequent conviction, shall be fined not more than \$500.

NOTE: The purpose of this bill is to prevent vehicles from driving more than seventy-five feet in a center lane designated for left turns.
