23	(a) The government shall conduct all activities in English
24	unless use of another language is required to provide
	constitutional protections or is required for activities related
	to the teaching of a foreign language.

- 1 (b) All official papers, records and documents produced or
- 2 used by the state, including ballots and other election
- 3 materials, must be in English, unless the papers or documents in
- 4 another language may be kept for historical or cultural purposes.

NOTE: The purpose of this bill is to insure that government agencies will not have to bear the expense of conducting activities and preparing and storing documents in multiple languages.
