22	(a) Each state institution of higher education shall waive
23	tuition for any member of the West Virginia State Police pursuant

- 1 (1) The member may attend any undergraduate or graduate course
- 2 if classroom space is available;
- 3 (2) The member is currently employed by the State Police;
- 4 (3) The member is a resident of this state;
- 5 (4) The member has applied and been admitted to the

- 7 (5) The member has applied for and submitted the Free
- 8 Application for Federal Student Aid;
- 9 (6) The member has exhausted all other sources of student
