10 A BILL to amend and reenact article 3, chapter 64 of the Code of
11 West Virginia, 1931, as amended, relating to authorizing the
12 Department of Environmental Protection to promulgate a
13 legislative rule relating to permits for construction and
14 major modification of major stationary sources of air
15 pollution for the prevention of significant deterioration.

16 *Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:*

17 That article 3, chapter 64 of the Code of West Virginia, 1931,
18 as amended, be amended and reenacted to read as follows:

19 **ARTICLE 3. AUTHORIZATION FOR DEPARTMENT OF ENVIRONMENTAL**
20 **PROTECTION TO PROMULGATE LEGISLATIVE RULES.**

21 **§64-3-1. Department of Environmental Protection.**

22 The legislative rule filed in the state register on the
23 twenty-eighth day of July, two thousand ten, authorized under the
24 authority of section four, article five, chapter twenty-two, of
25 this code, modified by the Department of Environmental Protection

1 to meet the objections of the Legislative Rule-Making Review
2 Committee and refiled in the state register on the eleventh day of
3 January, two thousand eleven, relating to the Department of
4 Environmental Protection (permits for construction and major
5 modification of major stationary sources of air pollution for the
6 prevention of significant deterioration, 45 CSR 14), is authorized.

8 NOTE: The purpose of this bill is to authorize the Department
9 of Environmental Protection to promulgate a legislative rule
10 relating to Permits for Construction and Major Modification of
11 Major Stationary Sources of Air Pollution for the Prevention of
12 Significant Deterioration.
