10 A BILL to amend and reenact article 9, chapter 64 of the Code of
11 West Virginia, 1931, as amended, relating to authorizing the
12 State Election Commission to promulgate a legislative rule
13 relating to the West Virginia Supreme Court of Appeals Public
14 Campaign Financing Pilot Program.

15 *Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:*

16 That article 9, chapter 64 of the Code of West Virginia, 1931,
17 as amended, be amended and reenacted to read as follows:

18 **ARTICLE 9. AUTHORIZATION FOR MISCELLANEOUS AGENCIES AND BOARDS TO**
19 **PROMULGATE LEGISLATIVE RULES.**

20 **§64-9-1. State Election Commission.**

21 The legislative rule filed in the state register on the
22 thirtieth day of July, two thousand ten, authorized under the
23 authority of section fourteen, article twelve, chapter three, of
24 this code, modified by the State Election Commission to meet the
25 objections of the Legislative Rule-Making Review Committee and
26 refiled in the state register on the fourteenth day of January, two

1 thousand eleven, relating to the State Election Commission (West
2 Virginia Supreme Court of Appeals Public Campaign Financing Pilot
3 Program, 146 CSR 5), is authorized.

5 NOTE: The purpose of this bill is to authorize the State
6 Election Commission to promulgate a legislative rule relating to
7 the West Virginia Supreme Court of Appeals Public Campaign
8 Financing Pilot Program.
