21	The legislative rule filed in the state register on the
22	thirtieth day of July, two thousand ten, authorized under the
23	authority of section fourteen, article twelve, chapter three, of
24	this code, modified by the State Election Commission to meet the
25	objections of the Legislative Rule-Making Review Committee and
26	refiled in the state register on the fourteenth day of January, two

thousand eleven, relating to the State Election Commission (West
Virginia Supreme Court of Appeals Public Campaign Financing Pilot
Program, 146 CSR 5), is authorized.
