10 A BILL to amend and reenact article 5, chapter 64 of the Code of  
11 West Virginia, 1931, as amended, relating to authorizing the  
12 Department of Health and Human Resources to promulgate a  
13 legislative rule relating to emergency medical services.

14 *Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:*

15 That article 5, chapter 64 of the Code of West Virginia, 1931,  
16 as amended, be amended and reenacted to read as follows:

17 **ARTICLE 5. AUTHORIZATION FOR DEPARTMENT OF HEALTH AND HUMAN**  
18 **RESOURCES TO PROMULGATE LEGISLATIVE RULES.**

19 **§64-5-1. Department of Health and Human Resources.**

20 The legislative rule filed in the state register on the  
21 thirtieth day of July, two thousand ten, authorized under the  
22 authority of section six, article four-c, chapter sixteen, of this  
23 code, modified by the Department of Health and Human Resources to  
24 meet the objections of the Legislative Rule-Making Review Committee  
25 and refiled in the state register on the twenty-fourth day of

1 January, two thousand eleven, relating to the Department of Health  
2 and Human Resources (emergency medical services, 64 CSR 48), is  
3 authorized.

5 NOTE: The purpose of this bill is to authorize the Department  
6 of Health and Human Resources to promulgate a legislative rule  
7 relating to Emergency Medical Services.

9 This section is new; therefore, strike-throughs and  
10 underscoring have been omitted.
