20	<u>§19-20-26. Purchase and sale of dogs.</u>
21	Notwithstanding any provision of this code to the contrary, no
22	dog may be bought, sold or in any other fashion taken from the care
23	of its mother if the dog is younger than eight weeks old in order
24	for the dog to obtain proper nutrients and care.

NOTE: The purpose of this bill is to prohibit a dog younger than eight weeks of age from being bought, sold or in any other

fashion taken from the care of its mother.
