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10	A BILL to amend and reenact $\$48-25A-1$, $\$48-25A-2$ and $\$48-25A-3$ of
11	the Code of West Virginia, 1931, as amended, all relating to
12	expanding the responsibilities of the Maternal Mortality
13	Review Team to include infant mortality reviews; and renaming
14	it the Infant and Maternal Mortality Review Team.
15	Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:
16	That $$48-25A-1$, $$48-25A-2$ and $$48-25A-3$ of the Code of West
17	Virginia, 1931, as amended, be amended and reenacted, all to read
18	as follows:
19	ARTICLE 25A. INFANT AND MATERNAL MORTALITY REVIEW TEAM.
20	§48-25A-1. Legislative findings.
21	The Legislature finds that there is a need for a process to
22	study the causes of <u>infant and</u> maternal deaths. It has been found
23	that comprehensive studies indicate that maternal mortalities are
24	more extensive than first appear on death certificates. The
25	Legislature finds that more extensive studies would enable a more
26	fully developed plan to avoid these deaths in the future.

- 1 According to the April 2010 National Vital Statistics Report
- 2 of the Centers for Disease Control, West Virginia now ranks as the
- 3 state with the highest infant mortality in the country among white
- 4 infants.
- 5 The Legislature finds that more extensive studies of infant
- 6 mortalities and maternal mortalities would enable a more developed
- 7 plan to avoid these deaths in the future.

8 §48-25A-2. <u>Infant and</u> Maternal Mortality Review Team.

- 9 (a) The Maternal Mortality Review Team is hereby established
- 10 under the Office of Maternal Child and Family Health is continued
- 11 and renamed the Infant and Maternal Mortality Review Team. The
- 12 <u>Infant and</u> Maternal Mortality Review Team is a multidisciplinary
- 13 team created to review the deaths of all infant deaths and women
- 14 who die during pregnancy, at the time of birth or within one year
- 15 of the birth of a child.
- 16 (b) The Infant and Maternal Mortality Review Team is to
- 17 consist of the following members, appointed by the Governor:
- 18 (1) The Director of the Office of Maternal Child and Family
- 19 Health, who is to serve as the chairperson of the <u>Infant and</u>
- 20 Maternal Mortality Review Team and is responsible for calling and
- 21 coordinating all meetings;
- 22 (2) The Commissioner of the Bureau for Public Health or a
- 23 designee;
- 24 (3) The Chief Medical Examiner in the Bureau of for Public
- 25 Health or a designee;

- 1 (4) The Director of the Division of Vital Statistics or a 2 designee;
- 3 (5) Representation from each of the three medical schools in 4 the state;
- 5 (6) The Director of Obstetrics, the Director of the Neonatal
- 6 Intensive Care Unit and the Director of Pediatrics at each of the
- 7 tertiary care hospitals in the state;
- 8 (7) One representative of the West Virginia State Medical 9 Association;
- 10 (8) One representative of the West Virginia Nurses 11 Association;
- 12 (9) One representative of the West Virginia Society of 13 Osteopathic Medicine;
- 14 (10) One representative of West Virginia Academy of Family 15 Physicians;
- 16 (11) One representative of the West Virginia Chapter of the 17 American College of Nurse Midwives;
- 18 (12) One representative of the West Virginia Chapter of the
- 19 American College of Obstetrics and Gynecology;
- 20 (13) One representative of the West Virginia Chapter of the
- 21 American Academy of Pediatrics;
- 22 (14) The Director of the Child Fatality Review Team; and
- 23 (15) Any additional person that the chair of the team
- 24 determines is needed on a particular case being considered.
- 25 (c) Each member shall serve serves for a term of five years.

- 1 Of the members of the commission first appointed, one shall be
- 2 appointed for a term ending June 30, 2009, and one each for terms
- 3 ending one, two, three and four years thereafter.
- 4 (d) Members of the Infant and Maternal Mortality Review Team
- 5 shall, unless sooner removed, continue to serve until their
- 6 respective terms expire and until their successors have been
- 7 appointed and have qualified.
- 8 (e) An appointment of a physician, whether for a full term or
- 9 to fill a vacancy, is to be made by the Governor from among three
- 10 nominees selected by the West Virginia State Medical Association or
- 11 the organization to be represented on the team. When an
- 12 appointment is for a full term, the nomination is to be submitted
- 13 to the Governor not later than eight months prior to the date on
- 14 which the appointment is to become effective. In the case of an
- 15 appointment to fill a vacancy, the nominations are to be submitted
- 16 to the Governor within thirty days after the request for the
- 17 nomination has been made by the Governor to the chairperson or
- 18 president of the organization. When an association fails to submit
- 19 to the Governor nominations for the appointment in accordance with
- 20 the requirements of this section, the Governor may make the
- 21 appointment without nominations.
- 22 (f) Each member of the Infant and Maternal Mortality Review
- 23 Team shall serve without additional compensation and may not be
- 24 reimbursed for any expenses incurred in the discharge of his or her
- 25 duties under the provisions of this article.

1 §48-25A-3. Responsibilities of the Infant and Maternal Mortality

- 2 Review Team.
- 3 (a) The Bureau $\frac{1}{1}$ for Public Health in consultation with the
- 4 <u>Infant and</u> Maternal Mortality Review Team shall, pursuant to the
- 5 provisions of article three, chapter twenty-nine-a, promulgate
- 6 rules applicable to the following:
- 7 (1) The standard procedures for the establishment, formation
- 8 and conduct of the <u>Infant and</u> Maternal Mortality Review Team; and
- 9 (2) The protocols for the review of <u>infant and</u> maternal 10 mortalities.
- 11 (b) The Infant and Maternal Mortality Review Team shall:
- 12 (1) Review all deaths of all infants and of all women who die
- 13 during pregnancy, at the time of birth or within one year of the
- 14 birth of a child;
- 15 (2) Establish the trends, patterns and risk factors;
- 16 (3) Provide statistical analysis regarding the causes of
- 17 infant and maternal fatalities in West Virginia; and
- 18 (4) Promote public awareness of the incidence and causes of
- 19 <u>infant and</u> maternal fatalities, including recommendations for their
- 20 reduction.
- 21 (c) The Infant and Maternal Mortality Review Team shall submit
- 22 an annual report to the Governor and to the Legislature concerning
- 23 its activities and the incidents of infant and maternal fatalities
- 24 within the state. The report is due annually on December 1. The
- 25 report is to include statistics setting forth the number of infant

- 1 and maternal fatalities, identifiable trends in infant and maternal
- 2 fatalities in the state, including possible causes, if any, and
- 3 recommendations to reduce the number of preventable infant and
- 4 maternal fatalities in the state. The report is to also include
- 5 the number of infant and mothers whose deaths have been determined
- 6 to have been unexpected or unexplained.
- 7 (d) The <u>Infant and</u> Maternal Mortality Review Team, in the
- 8 exercise of its duties as defined in this section, may not:
- 9 (1) Call witnesses or take testimony from individuals involved
- 10 in the investigation of a an infant or maternal fatality;
- 11 (2) Contact a family member of the deceased <u>infant or</u> mother,
- 12 except if a member of the team is involved in the investigation of
- 13 the death and must contact a family member in the course of
- 14 performing his or her duties outside of the team; or
- 15 (3) Enforce any public health standard or criminal law or
- 16 otherwise participate in any legal proceeding, except if a member
- 17 of the team is involved in the investigation of the death or
- 18 resulting prosecution and must participate in a legal proceeding in
- 19 the course of performing in his or her duties outside of the team.
- 20 (e) Proceedings, records and opinions of the <u>Infant and</u>
- 21 Maternal Mortality Review Team are confidential, in accordance with
- 22 section one, article seven, chapter forty-nine of this code, and
- 23 are not subject to discovery, subpoena or introduction into
- 24 evidence in any civil or criminal proceeding. Nothing in this
- 25 subsection is to be construed to limit or restrict the right to

- 1 discover or use in any civil or criminal proceeding anything that
- 2 is available from another source and entirely independent of the
- 3 proceedings of the Infant and Maternal Mortality Review Team.
- 4 (f) Members of the Infant and Maternal Mortality Review Team
- 5 may not be questioned in any civil or criminal proceeding regarding
- 6 information presented in or opinions formed as a result of a
- 7 meeting of the team. Nothing in this subsection may be construed
- 8 to prevent prevents a member of the Infant and Maternal Mortality
- 9 Review Team from testifying to information obtained independently
- 10 of the team or which is public information.

NOTE: The purpose of this bill is to expand responsibilities the Maternal Mortality Review Team to include reviewing infant mortalities.
