10 A BILL to amend and reenact §60-3A-18 of the Code of West Virginia,  
11 1931, as amended, relating to permitting the sale of liquor on  
12 election day.

13 *Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:*

14 That §60-3A-18 of the Code of West Virginia, 1931, as amended,  
15 be amended and reenacted to read as follows:

16 **ARTICLE 3A. SALES BY RETAIL LIQUOR LICENSEES.**

17 **§60-3A-18. Days and hours retail licensees may sell liquor.**

18 Retail licensees may not sell liquor on Sundays and Christmas  
19 ~~or election~~ day, or between the hours of twelve midnight and eight  
20 o'clock a.m., except that wine and fortified wines may be sold on  
21 ~~such~~ those days and at such times as authorized in section thirty-  
22 four, article eight of this chapter.

NOTE: The purpose of this bill is to permit the sale of liquor  
on election days.

Strike-throughs indicate language that would be stricken from  
the present law, and underscoring indicates new language that would  
be added.
