## 1 §5-10-22k. Cost-of-living adjustments for certain annuitants.

- 2 (a) As an additional cost-of-living adjustment to other
- 3 retirement allowances provided, a cost-of-living adjustment to
- 4 retirement benefits shall be paid to retirees of the system as
- 5 provided in subsection (b) of this section. The cost-of-living
- 6 adjustment shall equal \$1,500 and shall commence on July 1, 2011.
- 7 (b) The cost-of-living adjustment provided by this section
- 8 applies to any retiree who currently receives an annual retirement

NOTE: The purpose of this bill is to provide a cost-of-living increase for state employees and retirees who receive an annual annuity.
