10 A BILL to amend and reenact §30-27-10 of the Code of West Virginia,
11 1931, as amended, relating to licensing of barbers and
12 cosmetologists; changing the requirements for acquiring a
13 renewal of a barber's license; and changing the requirements
14 for continuing education for barbers.

15 *Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:*

16 That §30-27-10 of the Code of West Virginia, 1931, as amended,
17 be amended and reenacted to read as follows:

18 **ARTICLE 27. BOARD OF BARBERS AND COSMETOLOGISTS.**

19 **§30-27-10. Professional license and certificate renewal**
20 **requirements.**

21 (a) A professional licensee and certificate holder shall
22 annually or biennially on or before January 1, renew his or her
23 professional license or certificate by completing a form prescribed
24 by the board, paying the renewal fee and submitting any other
25 information required by the board.

26 (b) The board shall charge a fee for each renewal of a license
27 or certificate, and a late fee for any renewal not paid by the due

1 date.

2 (c) The board shall require as a condition of renewal of a
3 professional license or certificate that each licensee or
4 certificate holder complete continuing education, unless a barber
5 has been licensed and actively cutting hair for five continuous
6 years.

7 ~~(d) The board may deny an application for renewal for any~~
8 ~~reason which would justify the denial of an original application~~
9 ~~for a license or certificate.~~

NOTE: The purpose of the bill is to prevent barbers who have been licensed and cutting hair for five years from having to receive continued education.

Strike-throughs indicate language that would be stricken from the present law, and underscoring indicates new language that would be added.
