10	A BILL to amend the Code of West Virginia, 1931, as amended, by	
11	adding thereto a new section, designated §18-9D-22, relating	
12	to authorizing the School Building Authority to award grants	
13	or moneys to county and local library boards in connection	
14	with public library construction projects, from any funds	
15	appropriated by the Legislature; defining "public library	
16	construction project"; requiring a demonstration of county or	
17	local effort and fund raising before grants or moneys may be	
18	awarded for a public library construction project; describing	
19	what costs may be paid by the School Building Authority;	
20	setting forth additional powers of authority concerning	
21	construction projects; and authorizing the authority to	
22	establish guidelines and procedures for the award of grants or	
23	moneys for public library construction projects.	
24	Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:

1 That the Code of West Virginia, 1931, as amended, be amended 2 by adding thereto a new section, designated §18-9D-22, to read as 3 follows:

4 ARTICLE 9D. SCHOOL BUILDING AUTHORITY.

## 5 §18-9D-22. Public library construction projects.

(a) In addition to all other powers and authority granted to 6 7 the authority under this article, the authority has the power and 8 authority to award grants and moneys to any county or local library 9 board in the state for a public library construction project or 10 projects from any funds appropriated by the Legislature for those 11 purposes from time to time. For purposes of this section, a "public 12 library construction project" means a project with a cost of 13 greater than \$1 million for the new construction, expansion or 14 major renovation of facilities, buildings or structures for public 15 library purposes, including the acquisition of land for current or 16 future use in connection with the public library construction 17 project, new or substantial upgrading of existing equipment, 18 machinery or furnishings, and the installation of utilities or 19 other similar items related to making the public library 20 construction project operational. No grant or moneys may be awarded 21 under this section unless the authority determines that the county 22 or local library board, or one or more organizations or groups 23 affiliated with the county or local library board, has raised or 24 will raise funds at the county or local level, in an amount the

1 authority in its discretion deems reasonable and appropriate to 2 demonstrate substantial county or local effort in support of the 3 public library construction project. The local or county funds 4 required to be raised by the county or local library board, or one 5 or more organizations or groups affiliated with the county or local 6 library board, may be raised before or after the effective date of 7 this section. (b) Any grants or moneys awarded by the authority under this 8 9 section to a county or local library board may be used to pay for 10 any and all costs of or associated with the public library 11 construction project, including the cost of construction, 12 expansion, renovation, repair and safety upgrading of facilities, 13 buildings and structures for public library purposes, the cost of 14 land, equipment, machinery, furnishings, installation of utilities 15 and other similar items related to making the public library 16 construction project operational, and the cost of financing,

17 <u>interest during construction</u>, professional service fees and all 18 <u>other charges or expenses necessary</u>, appurtenant or incidental to 19 the foregoing.

20 (c) In addition to the power and authority to award grants and 21 moneys to any county or local library board in the state for a 22 public library construction project, the authority has all powers 23 set forth in sections three and section twenty of this article with 24 respect to public library construction projects.

1 (d) The authority may establish guidelines and procedures for 2 the award of grants or moneys for public library construction 3 projects, to promote the intent and purposes of this section and 4 assure the prudent and resourceful expenditure of state funds for 5 public library construction projects under this section.

NOTE: The purpose of this bill is to authorize the School Building Authority to award grants and moneys to county or local library boards for public library construction projects, based on a demonstration of substantial county or local effort as evidenced by county or local fund raising, from any moneys that may be appropriated by the Legislature to the School Building Authority for those purposes from time to time.

This section is new; therefore, it has been completely underscored.
