6 Requesting the Division of Highways that bridge number 51-20-7.19

7         on Route 20 near Glade View in Webster County be named the

8         "Honorary and Memorial Firefighters Bridge."

9         WHEREAS, West Virginia's first responders place their lives on

10 the line for the safety of their neighbors and communities, many of

11 them volunteering their time and efforts; and

12         WHEREAS, Webster County is served by five fire departments,

13 including the Cowen Volunteer Fire Department, the Diana Fire

14 Department, the Erbacon Volunteer Fire Department, the Hacker

15 Valley Volunteer Fire Department and the Webster Springs Volunteer

16 Fire Department; and

17         WHEREAS, These five fire departments consist of all volunteer

18 forces; and

19         WHEREAS, These brave men and women, and the honorary

20 firefighters who provide them support and encouragement, deserve to

21 have their commitments, efforts and sacrifices recognized;

22 therefore, be it

23         *Resolved by the Legislature of West Virginia:*

24         That the Legislature hereby requests the Division of Highways

25 to name bridge number 51-20-7.19 on Route 20 near Glade View in

1 Webster County the "Honorary and Memorial Firefighters Bridge";  
2 and, be it

3       *Further resolved,* That the Division of Highways is hereby  
4 requested to erect signs at both ends of the bridge proclaiming the  
5 bridge as the "Honorary and Memorial Firefighters Bridge"; and, be

7       *Further resolved,* That the Clerk of the House of Delegates  
8 forward a certified copy of this resolution to the Commissioner of  
9 the Division of Highways, the Cowen Volunteer Fire Department, the  
10 Diana Fire Department, the Erbacon Volunteer Fire Department, the  
11 Hacker Valley Volunteer Fire Department and the Webster Springs  
12 Volunteer Fire Department.
