



1           That the Joint Committee on Government and Finance authorize  
2 the Joint Committee on Health and the Joint Committee on  
3 Infrastructure to both study the impact of state and local laws,  
4 regulations, and policies on the safety and convenience of use of  
5 pedestrian routes to and from schools; and, be it

6           *Further Resolved,* That the Committees on Health and  
7 Infrastructure both report to the Joint Committee on Government and  
8 Finance prior to the first day of the regular session, 2012, on  
9 their findings, conclusions and recommendations together with  
10 drafts of any legislation to effectuate their recommendations; and,  
11 be it

12           *Further Resolved,* That the expenses necessary to conduct this  
13 study, to prepare a report and to draft necessary legislation be  
14 paid from legislative appropriations to the Joint Committee on  
15 Government and Finance.
