WHEREAS, Capt. Jackie Lee Dickens served in the Air Force in South Vietnam and began his tour of duty on August 13, 1968; and

WHEREAS, Capt. Jackie Lee Dickens was killed in action on June 2, 1969;

WHEREAS, PFC. Kent Howell was born on March 30, 1949, in Van, West Virginia;

WHEREAS, PFC. Kent Howell served in the United States Marine Corps in South Vietnam;

WHEREAS, PFC. Kent Howell was killed in action on September 29, 1968; and

WHEREAS, PFC. Kent Howell is survived by his brother Mitch Howell; therefore, be it

Resolved by the West Virginia Legislature:

That the Legislature hereby requests the Division of Highways to name that portion of Route 85 in Van South to Van Park as the
