6 Requesting the bridge in Rachel, Marion County, West Virginia on  
7        County Route 44, known as the Rachel Box Beam Bridge,  
8        specifically at mile post 6.49, be named the "Fletcher  
9        Brothers Memorial Bridge."

10        WHEREAS, Warren, William, John, James and George Fletcher were  
11 all born and raised in West Virginia; and

12        WHEREAS, Warren, William, John and James were enlisted in the  
13 United States Army; and

14        WHEREAS, George was enlisted in the United States Marine Corps;  
15 and

16        WHEREAS, All five of the Fletcher brothers were honorably  
17 discharged from the military after faithful and courageous service  
18 to their state and country during World War II; therefore, be it

19        *Resolved by the Legislature of West Virginia:*

20        That the Division of Highways is hereby requested to name the  
21 Rachel Box Beam Bridge, specifically at mile post 6.49 bridge in  
22 Rachel, Marion County, West Virginia on County Route 44, the  
23 "Fletcher Brothers Memorial Bridge"; and, be it

24        *Further Resolved,* That the Commissioner of the Division of

1 Highways is hereby requested to cause to be fabricated signs to be  
2 erected at each entryway of the bridge, containing bold and  
3 prominent letters proclaiming the bridge to be named the "Fletcher  
4 Brothers Memorial Bridge"; and, be it

5 *Further Resolved,* That the Clerk of the House of Delegates  
6 forward a certified copy of this resolution to the Commissioner of  
7 the Division of Highways and the surviving family of the five  
8 Fletcher Brothers.
