8 article eleven, chapter three of the Code of West Virginia, 1931,
9 as amended, such proposed amendment is hereby numbered "Amendment
10 No. 1" and designated as the "Amendment clarifying that nothing in
11 this Constitution secures or protects a right to abortion or
12 requires the funding of an abortion" and the purpose of the
13 proposed amendment is summarized as follows: "Nothing in this
14 Constitution secures or protects a right to abortion or requires
15 the funding of an abortion."

NOTE: The purpose of this resolution is to amend the State Constitution to clarify that nothing in the Constitution secures or protects a right to abortion or requires the funding of an abortion.

Strike-throughs indicate language that would be stricken from the present Constitution, and underscoring indicates new language that would be added.
